

Shirdi Sai



At age of 16 years Shri Saibaba arrived at the Village of Shirdi in Ahmednagar district of Maharashtra and remained there till his death. Saibaba found shelter in Khandoba temple, where a village Mahalsapathi in the temple addressed him as Sai or Saint Sai baba. Shri Saibaba of Shirdi lived between 1838 and 1918, whose real name, birthplace and date of birth are not known. An Indian spiritual guru and a fakir, Shri Shirdi Saibaba in Shirdi was regarded with great reverence by both Hindu and Muslim followers. Sri Shirdi Sai philosophy ingrained 'Shraddha' meaning faith and 'Saburi' were the supreme attributes to reach the state of godliness.
